

Level 3 Award in Education and Training (AET)

Classroom Learning

Overview

The Level 3 Award in Education and Training (AET) course is a teaching qualification in the Further Education (FE) sector, designed to prepare a person who is new to teaching or training, or considering taking on a role as a teacher/trainer. It is the first of a number of qualifications that have been designed to give a teacher/trainer the 'building blocks' to become more skilled in their role.

Course Requirements

There are no specific requirements for this course, however, learners should be able capable of studying at Level 3. Maths and English at Level 2 are desirable.

Delivery

Face-to-face. Additional access to our online learning platform.

Duration

Classroom delivery – 3 or 4 days (depending on cohort size).

1 month from date of enrolment to submit all assignments.

Assessment

Four written assignments.

Participation in a Microteach session where you will deliver a 20min session and participate as a learner for your peers.

Written reflective practice.

Accreditation

Learners will achieve a regulated qualification awarded through Open Awards.
